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PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAMME

The goal of the programme is to train all rounded advanced public health professionals in public health issues.

LEARNING OUTCOMES OF THE PROGRAMME

Upon the completion of the course, the graduate will acquire knowledge; develop skills and attitudes in

1. Advanced analytical and conceptual capabilities in public Health.
2. Advanced biostatistical capabilities in public health
3. Advanced application of diagnostic screening and testing in public health practice.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

The following shall be eligible for registration for the Master of Science in Public Health

1. M.Sc. in Public Health, International Health, Public Health or Epidemiology or any other health related from Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology (JKUAT) or from any other institution recognized by the JKUAT senate.
2. In addition to the above, the applicant should also have satisfied the minimum entry requirements for admission to an undergraduate degree programme.

DURATION AND PATTERN OF THE PROGRAMME

- The programme shall be pursued for three (3) academic years, a period of at least thirty-six (36) months from the date of registration and shall not exceed sixty (60) months.
- The programme shall consist of coursework, research, and thesis
